Vice President

The Vice President will serve a four-year term, with the possibility of re-election for two more years. Amended 07-02-2011 to read: The Vice President shall serve a coterminous term with the President. If the President is elected for four years, the Vice President shall serve a four year term. If the President is elected for a second term of two years, the Vice President, same person or new, shall also serve a two year term. In this way each election of officers always includes the election of both a President and Vice President.
